Luke 6:37 is referring to judging the actions/opinions of others while appointing ourselves as the final authority of determining their guilt and innocence.

If we look at the situations or actions of others without consideration, understanding or care for the truth, and pronounce a judgement against them (whether in our heart privately or in public), then we should expect to have our circumstances and actions scrutinized in the same way.
