Our Should Match Our Matthew 7:15 NLT "Beware of false prophets who come disguised as harmless sheep but are really vicious wolves. You can identify them by their fruit, that is, by the way they act." A practical example of this principle is seen in this letter written by major Sullivan Ballou of the Union Army to his wife, Sarah, a week before the battle of Bull Run, July 14, 1861. They had been married only six years. -(Focus on the Family Newsletter, March, 1994) "My Very Dear Sarah: The indications are very strong that we shall move in a few days perhaps tomorrow. Lest I should not be oble to write again, I feel impelled to write a few lines that may fall under your eye when I shall be no more I have no misgivings about or lack of confidence in the cause in which I am engaged, and my courage does not halt or falter. I know how strongly American civilization now leans on the triumph of the Government, and how great a debt we owe to those who went before us through the blood and suffering of the Revolution. And I am willing, perfectly willing, to lay down all my joys in this life to help maintain this Government and to pay that debt Sarah, my love for you is deathless: it seems to bind me with mighty cables that nothing but Omnipotence could break, and yet m love for country comes over me like a strong wind and bears me irresistibly on, with all these chains to the battle-field. The memories of all the blissful moments I have spent with you come creeping over me, and I feel most deeply grateful to God, and you, that I have enjoyed them so long. And how hard it is deathless: it seems to bind me with mighty cables that nothing but Omnipotence could break, and yet me to give them up and burn to ashes the hopes of future years, when, God willing, we might still have lived and loved together and seen our sons grown up to honorable manh	A.
