Study at the University of California Irvine (Published Jan 2020) "We found that children intuitively hold grudges but have to be taught to show gratitude" - Nadia Chernyak, UC Irvine assistant professor of cognitive sciences and lead author of the study.

It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out. Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance."

Logizomai Definition: To reckon inward, count up or weigh the reasons, compute, calculate, suppose, deem, judge.
Colossians 3:12-14 NLT "Since God chose you to be the holy people he loves, you must clothe yourselves with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others. Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony."

4. Forgiveness Us From Death				
Mayo Clinic Article on Forgiveness: "Why is it so easy to hold a grudge?"				
Being hurt by someone, particularly someone you love and trust, can cause anger, sadness and confusion. If you dwell on hurtful events or situations, grudges filled with resentment, vengeance and hostility can take root. If you allow negative feelings to crowd out positive feelings, you might find yourself swallowed up by your own bitterness or sense of injustice.				
What are the effects of holding a grudge?				
 If you're unforgiving, you might: Bring anger and into every relationship and new experience Become so wrapped up in the wrong that you can't enjoy the present Become depressed or Feel that your life lacks meaning or purpose, or that you're at odds with your spiritual beliefs 				
Bitterness is like swallowing and hoping it hurts someone else.				
Ephesians 4:30-32 NLT "And do not bring sorrow to God's Holy Spirit by the way you live. Remember, he has identified you as his own, guaranteeing that you will be saved on the day of redemption. Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander, as well as all types of evil behavior. Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you." The physical health benefits of forgiving those who have wronged us are very real but they are not most important.

Matthew 6:14-15 NLT "If you forgive those who sin against you, your heavenly Father will forgive you. But if you refuse to forgive others, your Father will not forgive your sins."
