Galatians 5:13-15 NLT "For you have been called to live in freedom, my brothers and sisters. But don't use your freedom to satisfy your sinful nature. Instead, use your freedom to serve one another in love. For the whole law cabe summed up in this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." But if you are always biting another one another, watch out! Beware of destroying one another."
Here Paul sets out a clear choice: Use our to satisfy our sinful nature or server others.
Galatians 5:16-18 NLT "So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves. The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit wants. And the Spirit gives us desires that are the opposite of what the sinful nature desires. These two forces are constantly fighting each other, so you are not free to carry out your good intentions. But when you are directed be the Spirit, you are not under obligation to the law of Moses.
Galatians 5:22-23 NLT But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!"
