Scholars indicate the beliefs of the Colossian people were similar to the New Age / New Spirituality beliefs in our western culture today. Those beliefs included:

- Gnosticism: Secret Spiritual Knowledge, Anything Material is Evil, Anything Spiritual is Good
- Angel Worship: Belief that Angelic Beings (not God) Created the World and Mankind
- Essenism: Communal Living, Dedicated to Poverty, Daily Meditation to Become One with the Universe
- Asceticism: Extreme Self Denial for Religious Purposes
- Endorsed Selfish Impulses: Sexual Immorality, Fleshly Impulses Were Encouraged
