The church is not a gathering for perfect people to remember how bad they used to be.
Church a gathering of believers who draw closer to Jesus through the teaching of God's word, Godly relationships, Biblical encouragement, honest prayer, and real accountability.

Church wounds are especially hurtful because our best qualities are used against us.
- You worked extra hours to be able to financially contribute to a cause of
the church and the leadership misused the funds.
- You took a risk and told someone your secret and they used it to gossip
about you later.
- I was tired and spent from a very long work week, but I showed up
anyways to serve at the church. I rearranged my entire schedule to make sure I was available on the days the church needed help and they didn't even care or acknowledge the sacrifice.
- I came to church looking for real friends who would be a good and
positive influence on me and I saw hypocrites who struggled with the same stuff I struggle with.
- I believed what I was told about the Bible and found out later it didn't
say what was presented and the pastor was using it to control and manipulate others for his own benefit.

- You look for ways to complain because you were optimistic before.

You have allowed cynicism to replace faith.
